

The Queen's Young Leaders Programme run by The Queen Elizabeth Diamond Jubilee Trust and its partners Comic Relief, the Royal Commonwealth Society and the Institute of Continuing Education of the University of Cambridge, aims to discover, celebrate and develop exceptional young people from every country in the Commonwealth who are taking the lead in their communities and using their skills to transform lives. Winners of this prestigious Award receive a unique package of training, mentoring and networking to develop their leadership skills, including a one-week residential programme in June in the United Kingdom during which they receive their Award from Her Majesty The Queen.

The Programme was launched in 2014 and there are 60 award winners annually. Applications have been received in ever growing numbers from across the Commonwealth. There are now Queen's Young Leaders in every one of the Commonwealth's 52 countries.

The four-year Programme will end in 2018. On 29 June 2017, when this year's winners, from 36 Commonwealth countries, receive their awards from Her Majesty The Queen at Buckingham Palace, the application process will open to find the final cohort of Queen's Young Leaders. Young people aged from 18 to 29 from every country in the Commonwealth will be able to apply online at www.queensyoungleaders.com <<http://www.queensyoungleaders.com>>. The deadline for applications is 21 August 2017. The final 60 Award winners will be announced in December 2017.

In this final application round, we are casting the net as widely as possible in order to ensure that we attract the strongest applications from every Commonwealth country. We would welcome your help with this. Attached you will find guidance and materials to promote the programme on websites and social media. You may also wish to put the word out to relevant networks and/or encourage individuals known to you to take this final opportunity to put themselves forward for the Award when applications open.

In brief,

* Applicants need to have proven experience of working to improve their communities locally, regionally or at a national level and be able to show evidence of their achievements.

* Applicants must be aged between 18 and 29 throughout 2018.

* Applicants must be citizens of and working in a Commonwealth country or citizens of an Overseas Territory of a Commonwealth country.

* Applicants need to demonstrate evidence of their leadership qualities.

* All applicants need to be supported by a suitable referee. Priority will be given to individuals who have overcome challenges to achieve their goals.
